Considerations

The apple farm is tons of fun, and that's why it can get very busy on peak season weekends. Up to 20,000 people can visit the orchard on a single Saturday or Sunday from mid-September through early October. Weekdays are much quieter and may be a nice alternative to consider. Be sure to arrive early to secure a picnic table as we are unable to reserve tables, and bring along plenty of adult supervision. Sorry, no outside food is allowed into the orchard.
